This year, the “Printemps Irlandais” will be held on March 21, 22 and 23rd 2025 In the surroundings of Troyes located in Aube (10) department area.

- Every evening the organization secretary's office will be installed at Hotel des Sources from 18h00 to 19h00 and every morning from 8h00 to 8h30 to verify and finalize the day after entries.

On Friday March 21st

- 9h00 International Derby for dogs aged less than 2 years. Meeting point at Fédération des chasseurs de l'Aube - Maison de la chasse, Chemin de la queue de pelle, 10440 LA RIVIERE DE CORPS
- **13h00 Mid-day lunch will be taken on site so you have to provide your own supply.**
- 14h 30 Regional breed Show (without CACS) on the same site

- Confined stake ran in solo with attribution of CACT
- Europe Championship Confined stake ran in brace with attribution of CACIT. Stake only open to dogs who have already obtained an excellent award in a brace stake or a CACT in a solo stake or a classification in Winning Class.
- CACIT barrage
- Attribution of the European Champion title according to the two-day results.

PRECISIONS:

Complete rules for European championship and derby are available on request.

** PSI (Irish style prize)

On Saturday stakes judges can choose in their competition only one dog that, according to them, represents the ideal of the Irish setter of part: his gait, his head carrying and his style.

- This dog will have to have been classified at least once.
- Dogs having already won PSI in the past are excluded from selection.
- These dogs will be seen again last time by 2 judges on Saturday evening
- This jury will then indicate the winner of PSI.

Derby des jeunes (Novice stake)

- Confined stake to Irish Setters **aged less than 2 years at the day of the event.**
- Derby aims to select young hopes on their natural genetic qualities, it means before the hand of man has not changed, in good or bad, the expression of their natural qualities on the field.
- Selection criteria are in their highest rating: undertaking, passion, gait, style, find and set.
- Dogs already awarded with an EXC in spring trial or more will not be allowed to participate.

Derby will be judged as follows:

- The dogs of very great merit selected will be kept and will run on a second field in attempt to put them in presence of birds.
- Faults like flush and hare chasing are not necessarily playoffs.
- A solid set on partridge, long enough is required to win the Derby.
- Steadiness to wing is not required.
- The Derby winner will be presented on Saturday evening « barrages ».

ENTRIES

Many people in Europe reckon on your understanding to help them to make a success of this event. We ask you to return the Derby entry form correctly writhed up in capital blocks **before the mentioned dead line.**

Important:

Solo and brace stakes entries must be done exclusively on line through Gescon application (see attached information documents) **No entry will be possible on site.**

Some registrations processes can take several weeks so don't waste time to do it.

ENTRIES PROCESS

Printemps Irlandais Champagne 2025 (France)

Dead line for entries: 12 march 2025

Entries for the 2-day competition in Solo and Brace must mandatory be done through the application www.Gescon.fr
See separate entry form for Derby.

Entry conditions to participate to the European Championship are specified on the invitation document.

Specific conditions regarding the entries through Gescon.fr:

- The dog must be registered in the French kennel Club database
- The dog must be under 10 years old
- The dog must get a working carnet issued by his national kennel club
- Any French or foreign owner must be in possession of an « **owner** » license for pointing dogs, valid for the current year and on which **each** of his dogs must be mentioned.

Foreign dogs registration into SCC database

For foreign dogs a registration to the French database has to be done (free of charge and once for the dog's life) to Société Centrale Canine **before** the Licence request.

Fill in the form properly and follow the instructions regarding the documents to be send to SCC the French kennel club. (Note that it can take 1 or 2 weeks before confirmation)

Licence request

This request has to be done on the French kennel Club (Societe Centrale Canine) web site :

- 1- <https://www.espaces.centrale-canine.fr/EspaceLicence/cyn/elProprietaire.html?isCookieGAHasBeenActivated=true&isCookiePreferencesHasBeenSaved=false>
- 2- Click on « Devenez Licencié de la Société Centrale Canine »
- 3- You must choose the line « CHIENS D'ARRET » and click on « En Ligne » (delivery time is much longer when printing the form to send it by mail)
- 4- Then you must fill in the form with name, full address, telephone number etc...
- Identify your dogs one by one in order to be able to put them in your team on Gescon application later on.
- 5- After validation of your last dog, click on « Accéder au récapitulatif » to verify your inputs.
- 6- If OK Proceed to the on-line payment.
- 7- You will receive a confirmation of your licence by mail.

Any handler having a license can present his friend's dogs however their owners must also have their proper **« owner licence for the current year »**. That means the handler and the owner must have both a license.

Entries of your dog(s) in the program:

You can now enter your dogs in www.Gescon.fr if the above conditions (dogs registration and license has been confirmed.)

On the front page click on **"Inscription"**

Fill in the form with Name, Surname etc.. Choose your own password and confirm it.(if you already creates one in the past it's not necessary, just use your e-mail address and pass word as done in the previous years.

When completed click on **"Valider"**

Then you will receive by return an email from Gescon including a link.

Click on this activation link to access to the Gescon main menu.

From now on for further connection to Gescon click on **"Espace concurrent"** on the front page;

You will have then to fill in your email address and your password and click on **"Connexion"** to have a full access to the database.

1 – CREATE YOUR TEAM

In “Espace concurrent” click on “Mon équipe” (my team)

That means you have to register all the dogs you expect to entry in a stake during the season either if they are not sure to compete;

IMPORTANT This action can be done only after the SCC has sent the dog information to Gescon (as describe in chapter 1 here above) and after you get your licence. As these two informations are linked you can't go further if one is not completed.

To create a dog in your team choose “Rechercher un chien par tatouage ou transpondeur”

(means; search a dog by tattoo or microchip number)

Then tape the dog's tattoo or microchip number and the information regarding the dog should appear. Click on “Ajouter” (on the right hand side of the line) to add the dog in your team. You have to repeat this operation for each dog.

2 - DOGS ENTRIES through Gescon

On “Espace Concurrent” go to “Calendrier”

Here you will find all the details of places and dates of the French Field trials for the season.

Select the competition on which you want to entry a dog. For that click on the right hand side of the line on “Choisir cet évènement” (Choose this event)

Your team appears on the bottom of a new screen into chapter “En reserve”. (Stand by list)

Then unclick the dog(s) you want to entry in that stake. The dog(s) will be transferred to the chapter “à engager” (to enter list).

In “Série” choose between –Grande Quête – Couple (brace) – Solo 1 or Solo 2 and then tape the handler's name and surname (to fill in automatically the other handler cells drag the mouse over the first name and surname).

When your selections are completed click on “valider” and the result will be then transferred to “engagement préparés” (prepared entries)

3 – YOUR ENTRIES

On the main menu go to “Mes engagements” (my entries)

In chapter Engagements préparés you will find the inscriptions you have prepared (just above) for the different stakes you have selected.

To finalize your entries you will have to select the choice of payment by a click either on:

“Règlement autre” if the organization can't offer payment by credit card then the payment will be done on site but the entries will appear on the program only after the full payment is validated by the organization (this is the choice for the Red Club event)

Or on:

“Règlement par carte bancaire” (Payment on line by credit card) if the organization took this option. In this case your entries will be automatically valid. (this choice is not available for the Red Club)

Information: with a mouse right click you can print out your entries.

Entry fee for each stake 40€ per dog.

– Payment in Euros **exclusively by check on first class French bank or cash on site.**

4– OTHER INFORMATION

On the front page of Gescon.fr on chapter “Mon compte” (my account) you can modify your personal data and/or your password.

On chapter “Mes résultats” (my results) you can check when published the results of your team.

ENTRIES

REGIONAL BREED SHOW - TROYES

21 march 2025 - 14h30

The day before the European Championship and the associated Solo stakes the Red Club organizes a regional breed show.

This event will be this year judged by Mr Pascal Bouée.

Please note that this show is not awarded with CACS

The entries must be done on the www.sccexpo.fr web site only.

If you have some difficulties to enter your dog(s) you can use the following link for help:

Regarding the entries for foreign dogs there will be no problem if your dog is already registered in the SCC data base. If not you will have to fill-in the requested detailed information and send a scan of the pedigree.

To enter a dog in « classe travail » (working class) you will have to justify the result in field trial (minimum a Very Good award) and follow the here under link to ask the French kennel Club SCC for an attestation. If available you can also produce an attestation issued by the kennel club of your country if recognized by FCI.

If this attestation is not produced with the entry form the dog will be automatically entered in Open Class.

The dead line for entries is March 12th.

Note that the administration of the event being organized by the French Kennel Club (SCC) it will be impossible to enter any dog after this date.
